London Fire Brigade & Turnaround Project

This week, our Safeguarding Keyworkers, Jack and Phoebe, accompanied a group of pupils to East Ham Fire Station to support a crucial local safety initiative.

Following recent concerning incidents involving young people, we are taking decisive action to safeguard our community. In response to growing concerns about youth in Newham being targeted by high-harm networks using fire and arson in group conflicts, we have partnered with the London Fire Brigade (LFB) to establish a dedicated digital safeguarding platform.

Launched on September 15, 2026, this joint initiative provides a direct online portal for multi-agency referrals, early intervention, and confidential support—helping disrupt dangerous behaviors and protect vulnerable children from harm.

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Tunmarsh- Henna Patterns in Art



As part of their short study into global art forms, Year 11 Art pupils took a collaborative approach to traditional henna design.

Working together, students acted as both designers and canvases—consulting with their peers to conceptualise custom floral and geometric motifs, which were then applied directly.

The project allowed pupils to hone their visual planning skills while gaining a deeper appreciation for the artistry and cultural heritage of henna.

Strengthening Systems & Relational Support

Monday's Staff Development Session (SDS) focused on strengthening our school operations and relational behaviour support. Staff engaged in training around trauma-informed practices—emphasising restorative conversations and emotion coaching to support pupils with self-regulation—while reviewing updated standards for tracking attendance, positive behavior merits, and incident reporting using our BromCom and CPOMS systems.

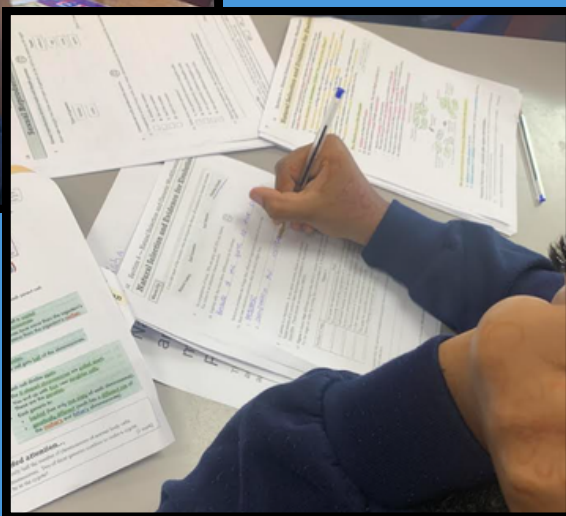

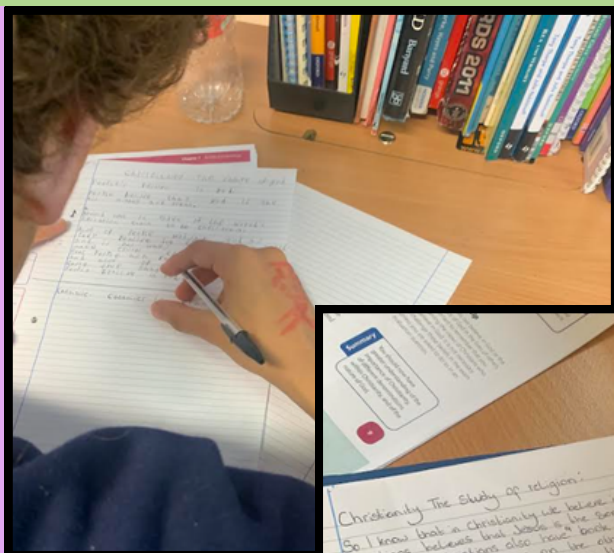


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Tunmarsh- Science & Chromosomes discussion KS4

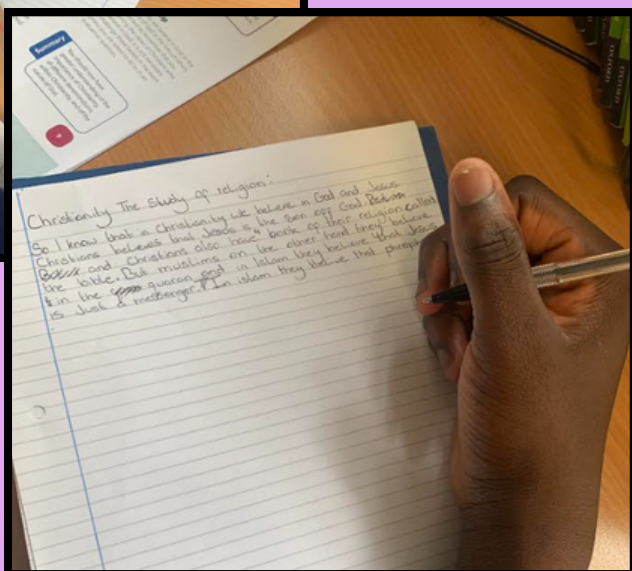


Key Stage 4 pupils have been diving deep into genetics this week, exploring the fascinating characteristics of chromosomes and learning how traits are passed down to offspring!

Punctuality Reward

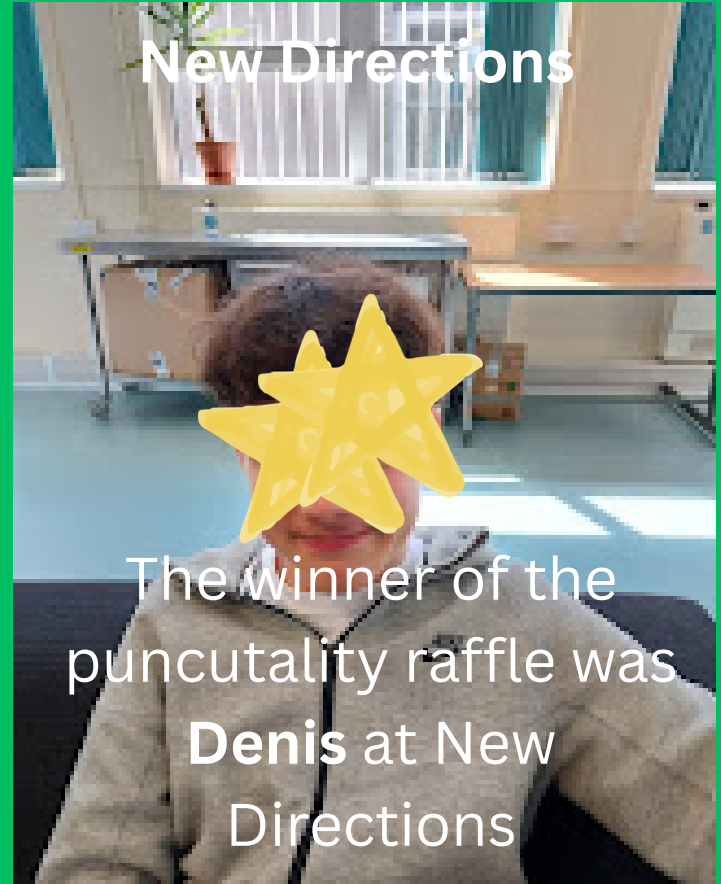
